Registration Dates

October 1, 2014 – Registration Opens On-Line
December 14, 2014 - Registration Closes
Middle School includes 6th-9th grades unless 9th grade is considered a part of your High School. Adult includes those ages 21 and older.

Registration Fee = \$130/person

Includes: 2-nights hotel lodging, Saturday box-lunch, Sat. eve celebration & snacks, service opportunity and awesome daytime interaction and night-life in Christ!

Meals

A sack lunch is provided for all participants on Saturday noon. Each group is on their own for dinner Friday and Saturday eve and breakfast on Saturday and Sunday.

A list of local restaurants will be posted on the web site. Special provisions are made by the hotel to provide inexpensive breakfast and meal-time items in the hotel.

Housing

Four youth and one adult are assigned to a two-bed hotel room. Adults are not allowed to share a bed with a youth. Each group must decide if either the adult or two youth will sleep on the floor and then bring sleeping bags and/or air mattresses. There are no roll-away beds allowed. (If you are flying rather than driving, and sleeping bags are inconvenient, please let us know.) Hotel rooms include hair dryers.

Safety & Security

The RMS is supplementing the security measures already in place at the hotel with additional caring adults who will have the specific role of supporting the congregation's adults already present, in the care and welfare for their youth.

What to Wear/Bring

- Comfortable clothing.
- Sleeping bags for one adult or two youth in the room.
- Saturday eve is the Community Celebration. More details will soon be announced.
- Bible.
- Ear plugs if room-mates snore!
- Offering recipients will be announced at a later date.

Follow These Steps

for a Stress-Free "Get-Ready, Register and Go" Process

- 1. Download pdf of Poster & Schedule. Add local contact/meeting info. Promote.
- 2. Download and read the **Guide to Selecting Adult Leaders**. NOTE: A minimum of one adult (21 and older) per 1 to 4 youth of the same gender is required.
- 3. Download **MSYG Permission and Medical form**(s). One for youth. One for adults. Copy and provide this form for each participating youth and adult.
- **4.** Collect a completed Permission and Release/Medical form for each participant. You will need this info before you complete the on-line registration process
- **5**. You will need two copies of the completed form one to keep and one to turn in at registration.

If a participant does not have medical insurance, contact Cheryl Almquist in the RMS office.

6. Complete the on-line registration process. Be aware of deadlines. A link to the on-line registration process is at: www.rmselca.org/msyg

- 8. Prepare for MSYG.
 - Raise funds. Complete forms. Build community. Bible study.
 - Download and discuss MSYG Covenant. Each participant sign.
 - Collect Permission and Medical Release forms and bring two copies to event.
 - Engage all Pre-Gathering Resources.
 - Prepare transportation. Commit to safe driving practices by all.
 - Ask your youth group and congregation to hold the 2016 MSYG in **prayer**.
