Position Summary

Adult Faith Formation Minister is a part-time position that is responsible for some pastoral care as well as the development, implementation, and oversight of intentional adult faith formation for newcomers and long-term members of ELC alike.

Principal Responsibilities

- Provide at-home or hospital visits and/or communion; lead or assist with grief/loss group; perform other pastoral care/needs in conjunction with Congregational Care Committee and as identified by the Pastor.
- With Pastor and staff, be actively involved in weekly worship planning; preach during Thursday evening worship services as needed.
- Help further identify existing member's gifts, passions and talents and assist them in finding appropriate outlets for their gifts. In collaboration with the Pastor, develop and implement a new member process that acquaints them with our congregation, children and youth ministries and possibilities for small group ministries.
- Identify, welcome, track and follow up with visitors and newcomers, inviting them to participate in the life of the congregation.
