ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

▪ Weekly Worship

- Support a music ministry that is spiritually impactful to all members and guests.
- Contribute piano/organ music for Sunday morning worship including prelude, postlude, and offertory (when needed).
- Accompaniment of hymns, choir/praise team, special music and other as needed.
- Attend meetings with the Director of Music Ministry as requested.
- Communicate special music with the Director of Music Ministry/office staff for timely bulletin deadlines.
- Expectations are to be present for Christmas, Advent Lent, Holy Week, and Easter. It is anticipated that during these high holy weeks, there will be extra hours needed.

▪ Adult Choir (Soli Dei) accompanist responsibilities:

- Accompany weekly rehearsals on Thursdays 7:00-8:00pm (September-May)*
- Accompany for any special music on Sundays (September-May)
- Collaborate with the director/conductor

▪ Praise Band responsibilities

- Accompany weekly rehearsals (Thursdays 6:00-7:00pm)*
- Accompany for any special music on Sundays

*times for rehearsal are subject to change

▪ Other Responsibilities

- Responsible for finding a substitute in the event of absence for yourself and communicating with the Director of Music Ministry at least two weeks before a planned absence.
- Perform additional duties as directed by the Director of Music Ministry.
- The organist/pianist is expected to dress appropriately for worship and present themselves in behavior conducive to worship leadership.
- First right of refusal is granted for weddings/funerals.
- Job performance review conducted annually by the Director of Music Ministry and a member of the Executive Council.
- 30 days written notice requested in the event of voluntary termination.
