Do Bring:

- Passport (necessary for crossing back into U.S. after visiting Ciudad Juarez if the group chooses to go)
- ID and Insurance Card
- Health Form
- Water bottle (Please stay hydrated; many people get dehydrated while visiting the desert lands of El Paso)
- Hat, sunglasses, sunblock, ChapStick
- Comfortable clothing
 - o **NOTE:** No booty shorts or tank top shirts
 - Season: Spring
 - Daytime: Stays between 75-95 degrees throughout the day
 - Nighttime: Drops into the 60s and 70s
 - No sleeveless shirts
 - Light jacket for air-conditioned spaces
 - Long pants or knee-high shorts
 - Close-toed walking shoes (make sure they are comfortable!)
 - May want to bring a nicer outfit for worship or dinners out.
 - Sandals and swimsuit for times of relaxation at the hotel
