COVENANTS

Congregations participating in the SAS program sign a covenant that outlines responsibilities and expectations of the congregation, the Synod, and GSB.

YOUR INVESTMENT

3E has negotiated a reduced price for SAS and your participation includes an investment in our ability to continue this program across the Rocky Mountain Synod. Scholarships are available for congregations based on the congregation's operating budget. Congregations are also asked to contribute back to the Synod 10% of the increased revenue generated.

The investment in SAS is \$3150, which includes the cost of a professional graphic artist contracted through SAS. Congregations separately pay for their printing costs. 3E makes scholarships available to *all* congregations based on operating budgets.

They are:

- Scholarships of \$1000 over \$300,000
- Scholarships of \$1500 under \$300,000
- Scholarships of \$2000 under \$200,000
- Scholarships of \$2500 under \$100,000
